Date	Activity	Special Notes
September 10 <sup>th</sup> – 21 <sup>st</sup> , 2021	Summer students first online registration through the <a href="#">Engineering Portal</a>	There will be a second registration period in January 2022 for students who do not register in September 2021.
October 4 <sup>th</sup> , 2021	First day that students can view and apply to summer postings through the ECC job portal	Jobs are typically posted for 2-3 weeks. Interviews can be held and offers extended any time after the job application deadline.
October - December 2021	Ongoing recruitment	Jobs postings, interviews, and offers are ongoing.
December 22 <sup>nd</sup> , 2021 – January 2 <sup>nd</sup> , 2022	ECC closed for winter break.	Job postings can be live during this time, but no new postings will be approved until after the break.
January, 2022	Winter registration	3 <sup>rd</sup> year engineering students (Jan 5 <sup>th</sup> to 19 <sup>th</sup> ) 2 <sup>nd</sup> year engineering students (New program)
January 2022 -April 2022	Ongoing recruitment	Jobs postings, interviews, and offers are ongoing.
Late April – June 6 <sup>th</sup> , 2022	Work term start date between late April to June 6 <sup>th</sup> , 2022	Students will receive an email with instructions on how to formalize the summer work term.
August 2022	Start preparing the Evaluation and Final Reflection Report	Evaluation form to be filled out and signed by manager
September 30, 2022	Final Evaluation and Final Reflection Report due	Documents to be submitted to Quercus by students
